- 3.) Upload of a letter expressing your commitment to a career in engineering.
- 4.) Upload of a short essay (300 words maximum) discussing your view of the role of the structural engineer in society.

Applicants selected as finalists should be available for an informal interview on the morning of Saturday, April 13, 2024. All candidates selected as finalists will receive student membership in SEAC. Scholarship winners will be announced no later than April 20.
