Past President Award Holly Janowicz

Legacy Award **Stan Neujahr**

The Legacy Award recognizes SEAC's longest active member for their many years of service.

Stan Neujahr attended the University of Texas in Austin and received a Bachelor of Science degree in Architectural engineering in 1975. He moved to Denver and worked for DMJM Phillips-Riester as a junior engineer on the movable stands and the north end zone seating of the old Mile High stadium. He subsequently went to work for J.R. Haney and Associates as a project engineer and became a registered engineer in 1980 when he started a consulting structural engineering firm and joined the Structural Engineers Association of Colorado. Mr. Neujahr

was president of Neujahr and Gorman Consulting Structural Engineers for 35 years and still practices structural engineering. He served on many of the committees of SEAC and was elected as a director in 2001. Mr. Neujahr was elected to the position of Treasurer of SEAC in 2005. As treasurer he transitioned the accounting to software and the organization officially became a 501(c)3 and began filing tax returns. As president- elect the organization started the practice of having vendors sponsor the monthly breakfast meetings to be able to continue these meetings at no cost to the members. Mr. Neujahr served as president of SEAC in 2007. In 2011 Mr. Neujahr was awarded the Orley O. Phillips award for his outstanding contributions to the engineering profession and industry. In 2008 Mr. Neujahr was asked by Mr. Bob Voiland to help start a scholarship program for SEAC which he served on for over 10 years and was a major contributor. Mr. Neujahr was honored in 2016 to become a life member of SEAC. SEAC is honored to present Stan Neujahr with the 2024 Legacy Award.

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



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
